PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Everyone is encouraged to participate fully in the life of the parish including Mass on weekends, religious education classes (RE), community service, whole community faith formation programs and parish events. You must “opt-in” to Flocknote communication and pay attention to the parish bulletin.

TRADITIONAL: Our Pre-K through 12th grade program meets on scheduled Sunday mornings from 10:45 am to noon. Snack and fellowship is after 9:30 am Mass until 10:40 am. We have opening prayer for K-6 as a large group (including adults) and classes begin at 10:45 am. We will end as a group outside or in the church from 11:45 to noon. Our closing prayer is signalled by the Angelus bell at noon. We will end promptly with the traditional prayer as the church bells ring. Drivers, families and community members are encouraged to participate.

HYBRID: Designed for special circumstances, the hybrid program is a mixture of classroom, parish and homeschooling. Parents should indicate their anticipated schedule (i.e. family conflict, sports, etc) and students attend all sessions that fit in their schedule. With the addition of Restored Order, the strictly homeschool option is not available for grades 3-12. Many parish activities and events are scheduled outside of the Sunday morning time to allow for some flexibility in meeting course expectations of study, liturgy, community service and prayer.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Confirmation for properly disposed students in Grades 3-12 will be this spring (dates TBD). Preparation will take place in family and/or youth retreats, faith formation events, and specialized sessions. First Reconciliation occurs in 2nd Grade and preparation is during the regularly scheduled RE classes. First Communion has been moved to Grade 3 by Bishop Libasci.
